Gather client data using assessment techniques Discern between normal and abnormal client assessments Evaluate images on monitors and operate equipment under variable lighting situations Adequately perceive depth in order to move and position equipment and transport patients safely Demonstrate tactile, gross, and fine motor skills sufficient to provide safe patient care, patient assessment, patient radiographic positioning, and equipment operation Accurately interpret alarms, normal speaking level sounds, and auscultatory sounds, (i.e. equipment, monitors, fire alarms, call bells)

## Intellectual

Use short and long-term memory to critically think and problem solve Apply critical thinking techniques to problem solve and adapt to unexpected situation changes Analyze client data to determine appropriate nursing intervention Safely calculate medication administration dosages
